

Crop the Lower Layer with the Top Layer 🗖




Shape is now CROPPING the top Q layer, using the shape's vector outlines.

Any Fill, Stroke, or Image is not visble.

(Note the CROP Icon.)





Clip the Top Layer with the Lower Layer








Bark (Image)

An Adjustment is added as a child to the top layer. (Note the ADJUSTMENTS Icon.)




Mask 🟴 - Change a Layer into a Mask Layer

Note - As of version 1.8.3.641 in Affinity Designer, Masks do not work outside of an artboard.



Right-click on the Layer Thumbnail.



Paint Brush Tool



Select desired Greyscale colour

Make sure the Mask Layer is still selected when you start painting. If not click on the thumbnail to re-select.




On a mask, painting with black conceals the masked layer contents. Painting with white reveals the masked layer contents.





Painting appears on the mask thumbnail.
