

HOW TO QUICKLY INPAINT BLANK AREAS OF A STRAIGHTENED/CROPPED IMAGE

- 1. Open image, crop and straighten, click Apply. There will be checkered sections at corners of image.
- 2. With image layer highlighted, click on LAYER>Rasterize and Trim.
- 3. SELECT>Alpha Range>Select Fully Transparent
- 4. SELECT>Grow/Shrink. This will open a separate panel. Set the radius at about 2 px so that there won't be a line in the final image.
- 5. EDIT>Inpaint. Wait for a few seconds for the inpainting process to be completed.
- 6. SELECT>Deselect. This will stop the marching ants.
- 7. Save image, either as .afphoto or export as JPG or PNG.




After steps 1, 2, and 3
