About these brushes

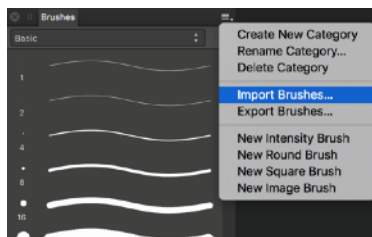
Provided in this download pack are four brush packs containing a total of 71 custom brushes in the Affinity Brush format. They provide a wide range of textural brush effects, great for creative artwork, digital painting and masking.

Installing the assets

By extracting this ZIP archive to a directory, you already have access to the brush categories - they now require importing into the Affinity apps to be able to use them.

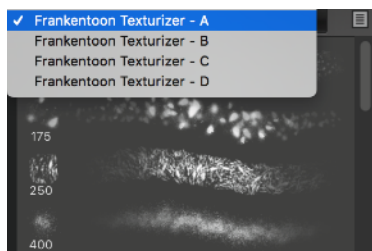
Installing the brushes

Within Affinity Photo or Affinity Designer, you will find a **Brushes** Panel. There are two ways of importing custom brushes into this list:



1) From the small dropdown icon to the right, choose **Import Brushes**. Navigate to where you extracted the ZIP archive and locate the ".afbrushes" files. Highlight an ".afbrushes" file and choose **Open** on the dialog.

2) From an **Explorer** (Windows) or **Finder** (macOS) window, locate the directory you extracted the ZIP archive to. Click-drag an ".afbrushes" file and offer it to the Affinity app you are using. The cursor icon will change; release the mouse button and a prompt will then appear to confirm the brushes have been imported. You can shift-select multiple ".afbrushes" files and import them all at the same time.



Once the brushes are imported, you can simply select the desired brush category, choose a brush and begin using it with the painting tools. **Note:** In Affinity Designer, ensure you are in the **Pixel** Persona for the brushes to appear (as they are raster brushes).
